



Junior, Student and Young Adult Membership at Horton Park Golf Club

Thank you for your interest in Membership of **Horton Park Golf Club** – part of the **Maple Leaf Golf Group**. In this pack you will find information on the many benefits of membership along with an application form. We would also be very happy to show any young players and their parents around the Club.

Maple Leaf Golf has a policy to actively encourage our junior players and our younger members are very important to us. Junior members at Horton Park Golf Club have the same playing rights as a full adult member with no restrictions on when you can play.

Those under 18 as at 1st September 2009 will be eligible for Junior Membership which is just £100 for the full year plus affiliation fees. Those between 18 and 21 will be eligible for our Young Adult Membership which is £200 for the full year plus affiliation fees. If you are in full time education then you are eligible for the Young Adult rate up until the age of 24. There is no joining fee applicable for Junior, Young Adult or Student members. Membership is based on a 12 month period, renewable on the annual anniversary of your date of joining.

At Horton Park Golf Club we have an 18-hole course – The Millennium, a 9-hole Par 3 course – The Academy - as well as a driving range.

By joining Horton Park Golf Club you are also becoming a member of the Maple Leaf Golf Group, meaning you have the benefit of playing at the group's other clubs on the Sussex coast for no extra charge. Our sister courses are on the Sussex coast and offer a fantastic range of courses and facilities.

Junior Roll Up: Every Saturday and Sunday from 12noon – 1pm and Wednesdays 4.30pm – 5.30pm our PGA Professionals run a Junior Roll Up which is open for members and non members. If you join the Club as a member then you can enter the roll up for no additional fee – a saving of £5 per session (free session limited to once a month).

Competitions: The Junior Organiser runs various Junior Leagues throughout the year which are based on an especially adapted 9-hole course using tees designated for Juniors. These are suitable for all levels and are an excellent way to gain a handicap. Please ask the Junior Organiser for more information.

Men's & Ladies Competitions: Players who have a handicap are eligible to join the competitions run by the adult sections as long as they have a valid handicap.

All you need to do to join is to complete the enclosed application form and read and complete our Child Protection information and forms and return them along with the payment and a passport size photograph. As part of the Club's Child Protection Policy it is important that the enclosed forms are completed in full and that both the Junior Member and their parent/guardian read the appropriate guidance notes.
